



California Price Changes Mixed February 4a & 4b milk prices By Bill Brooks

March 2, 2010

The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) announced the state's 4b (cheese) milk price for February yesterday at \$12.95/cwt. The price gained 23 cents from January's \$12.72/cwt., but is 20 cents below the calculation in last Friday's Weekly Recap. The price is \$2.84 higher than a year ago.

California's Class 4a (butter-powder) milk price, announced at \$12.84/cwt., is down 91 cents from last month's price. February's price is \$3.44 above 2009's price, but 3 cents lower than the calculation in last Friday's Weekly Recap.

CDFA will announce March prices no later than 4 p.m. PDT, April 1.
